Space is limited, so registration is free but required. Table Dimensions: 6 feet x 2-1/2 feet. Each table will be supplied with 2 chairs for representatives to answer questions. Organizations must supply their own table cover and may dress the tables as desired. However, no wall hangings are allowed. Please limit your display to your assigned table.

Setup starts at 3:30 p.m.. There is limited access to electrical outlets, so there is no guarantee that your table will have access. Please plan accordingly.
